OVERVIEW: Concordia, located in the vibrant and cosmopolitan city of Montreal, Quebec, is one of Canada's most innovative and diverse universities

and is one of the three universities in Quebec where English is the primary language of instruction (the others being McGill and Bishop's).

As of the 2020–21 academic year, there were 51,253 students enrolled in credit courses at Concordia, making the university among the largest in Canada by enrolment. The university has two campuses, set approximately 7 km apart: Sir George Williams Campus is the main campus, located in the Quartier Concordia neighbourhood of Downtown Montreal in the borough of Ville Marie; and Loyola Campus in the residential district of Notre-Dame-de-Grâce. With four faculties, a school of graduate studies and numerous colleges, centres and institutes, Concordia offers over 400 undergraduate and 200 graduate programs and courses.

RANKING: The university's J.M. School of Business consistently ranks among the top 10 Canadian business schools and the top 100 worldwide. Moreover, Concordia was ranked seventh in Canada and 229th among world universities in the International Professional Classification of Higher Education Institutions.

The university is a member of the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada, International Association of Universities, Canadian Association of Research Libraries, Canadian University Society for Intercollegiate Debate, Canadian Bureau for International Education and Canadian University Press. The university's varsity teams, known as the Stingers, compete in the Quebec Student Sport Federation of U Sports.

March 1 is the deadline to apply for fall term entry. International students are encouraged to apply by February 1 to allow sufficient time for CAQ and study permit application processing.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY:

TOEFL iBT Special home edition: Score 90 or higher, with a minimum combined score of 34 for speaking and writing. DUOLINGO: DET score of 120 and above with no sub-score under 90.

FOR IB STUDENTS

The following IB Math courses will satisfy the math requirement for science, business, engineering and computer science programs:

Cost & Scholarships

The total annual cost is from \$21.000 CAD up to \$25.000 CAD depending on the undergraduate program.

Concordia Presidential Scholarship: 100% - This is a newly established full flight award (This scholarship



will cover tuition and fees, books and living costs based on Concordia's residency rate. It is normally renewable up to four years assuming the students meet all renewal requirements) designed to support international undergraduate students who have shown academic excellence, community leadership and motivation to better the global community. Each year, this prestigious award will be granted to up to 2 incoming students from any faculty. IMPORTANT: You must apply for admissions prior to applying for this scholarship. *If you have request access and emailed your student ID to fundingyoureducation@concordia.ca, please allow 24-48 hours for access to be granted. Applicants who request access prior to the application deadline will be accepted.
