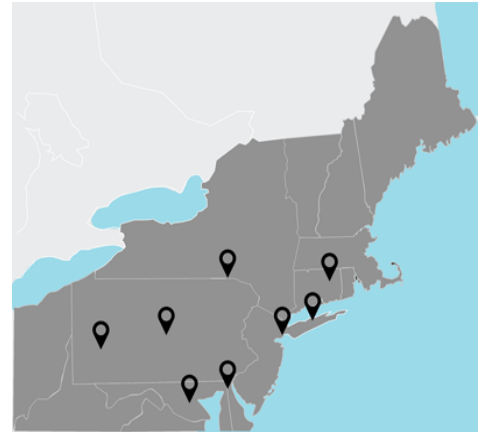




THE NORTHEAST PUBLIC SCHOOLS: PREPARING TO APPLY

OVERVIEW – LU is a highly ranked private research university in Bethlehem, the Lehigh Valley, Pennsylvania.
